What is a NHFG Wildlife Biologist? February 7th

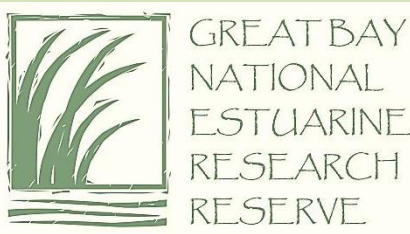
