For ages 2-5. 10:30a.m. -11:30a.m. on select Thursdays in January, February and March.

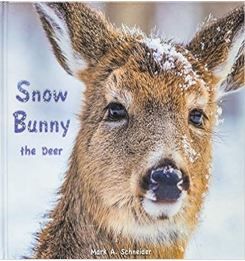

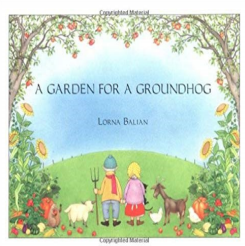
## January 10<sup>th</sup> Winter Wonderland by Jill Esbaum

Do you love winter and get excited when the snowflakes start to fall? Join us as we have some winter fun outside and make a craft to take home.



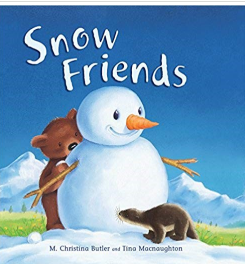
## January 24<sup>th</sup> Snow Bunny the Deer by Mark A. Schneider

Have you ever seen a deer in the wild? Join us as we learn about their first year and how they spend their winter. Craft a deer of your own to take home.



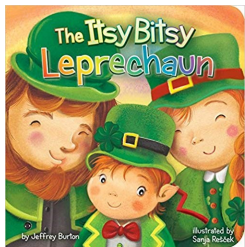
## February 14<sup>th</sup> A Garden for a Groundhog by Lorna Balian

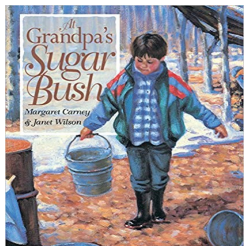
## February 28<sup>th</sup> Snow Friends by M. Christina Butler
